

Boy Scout Good Turn for Goodwill February 5 - 12, 2011

What's Going On?

February 5 - 12, 2011 is *Good Turn Week* for the Great Smoky Mountain Boy Scout Council.

Scouts will ask family and friends to collect gently used items for Goodwill Industries-Knoxville, Inc. during the week of February 5 - 12. **Scouts should take their donations to Goodwill by or on February 12.** Each scout that donates at least one tall kitchen bag full of donations will receive a Good Turn Patch.

When making their donations, scouts should be sure to have a **Goodwill employee sign the back of their donation form.** Scouts should return the signed donation forms to unit leaders.

What Can Unit Leaders Do?

Unit leaders will need to collect the completed (signed) scout donation forms and forward them to Jeff Bays at the Boy Scout Council. All forms must be submitted by February 21, 2011 to be eligible for patches; fax: 865.588.3728.
